Dear Sirs:

Please accept this correspondence in reference to asensioexposed.com, a web site currently hosted by HostMySite and a domain owned by Domains by Proxy, Inc. The site is solely and exclusively dedicated to distorting the professional record of Manuel P. Asensio. asensioexposed.com misrepresents multiple events in the career of Mr. Asensio, a well known investor and portfolio manager. (See enclosed Professional Biography)

Mr. Asensio holds you responsible for the libelous and slanderous language found in asensioexposed.com. If you do not immediately cease to provide services to asensioexposed.com and reveal the entity responsible for making payments to you in exchange for these services, he will have no choice but to pursue a legal resolution to this matter.

The content of asensioexposed.com has injured Mr. Asensio both professionally and personally. Here are only a few of the numerous misrepresentations publicized by your site.

- The site connects Mr. Asensio to Tony Elgindy, a convicted criminal. Yet Mr. Asensio has never had a professional or personal relationship with Mr. Elgindy. In fact, Mr. Asensio has never even had any direct or indirect contact with Mr. Elgindy.
- The site also misrepresents Mr. Asensio's compliance record. Though asensioexposed.com suggests that Mr. Asensio has been a regulatory problem for some years, he in fact spent 20 years as a FINRA member without a single customer complaint of any kind.
- The site's characterization of Mr. Asensio's resolution of litigation with Norman Murphy is completely false.

- The site misrepresents the 2002 jury verdict in connection with Mr. Asensio's research on Chromatics Color Sciences International, Inc.
- In numerous instances, the site claims Mr. Asensio was convicted of fraud. This is blatantly false; Mr. Asensio has never been convicted of fraud.
- The site claims Mr. Asensio used aliases to post on the Internet. All of Mr. Asensio's publications are attributable to his name.
- The site alleges without any evidence that Mr. Asensio's associates are responsible for producing his work; the site publishes the names of these associates.
- According to the site, Mr. Asensio's FINRA member firm was "expelled" from FINRA. Mr. Asensio's FINRA member firm was not subject of a single investigation and never received a single customer complaint in its entire history. Mr. Asensio voluntarily withdrew his FINRA membership in 2003 and voluntarily withdrew his firm's membership in 2007. Neither event was the result of any adverse regulatory ruling.

Mr. Asensio anticipates your immediate cooperation with this request.
